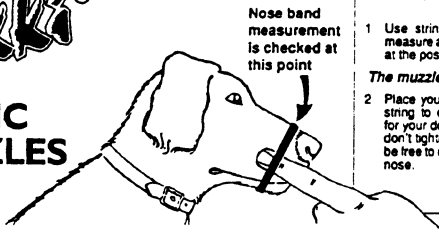

Selecting the right muzzle for your dog

- 1 Use string (or fabric tape) to measure around your dog's nose at the position shown.
 - 2 Place your forefinger under the string to ensure enough space for your dog to be comfortable - don't tighten the string, it should be free to move around the dog's nose.
 - 3 Lay the string along the scale and check off the muzzle size - if it is not an exact match then take the nearest size.
 - 4 Fit the selected muzzle on your dog. Check the fit by running your finger inside the noseband. Your dog must be able to pant and have free tongue movement.
- Better a little too loose than too tight!**

The muzzle must not be tight

- **Make sure that you have the right muzzle for your dog.**
- **Don't leave a muzzled dog unattended.**
- **Muzzling is for restraint, not punishment.**
