



## Equine Hood System

Congratulations on your equine hood system purchase.

### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE** - Please read carefully

General Step by Step Guidelines:

1. Secure the animals by tying it up or placing the animal in cross ties.
2. Brush any dirt away from the head and loosen the halter one or two notches.
3. Pre-warm the hood system by plugging in the appliance and placing it on the high setting for a few minutes before placing on the patient.
4. Fasten the hood comfortably on the patient using the Velcro Straps.
5. Turn hood appliance on the high for first 10 minutes of therapy.
6. After the initial ten minutes, turn the heat to the low setting and maintain this setting until the therapy session is complete.
7. Disinfect the inside of the hood after use and allow it to dry before storage in a clean place.
8. If necessary sponge off the animal's head after treatment.

### **Important Safety Instructions**

- Never use the hood along with any type of liniment, salve or ointment.
- Do not plug in and leave unattended. Check hide under device frequently.
- Do not immerse the hood cover in water unless the electrical pads and cord have been removed.
- Do not use pins or other metallic objects to hold cover in place.
- Never use pads without outer cover in place.
- Occasionally check the inner PVC around the heat pads to ensure they have not deteriorated over time.
- Do not fold or bend the heat element.
- Do not pull the hood by the cord or use the cord as a handle.

### Assembly Instructions



- \* There are 2 pads in the Hood system
- \* One pad is positioned on top of the forehead, midway between the eyes and one pad is positioned mid centre beneath the jaw.
- \* The “hard side” of the pad should be placed inside the hood cover so that the inward side is touching the animal when the hood is in place.
- \* Each pad plugs into the harness which runs up through the top end of the system
