Gray Touch-Up for Smoke Colored Livestock

Sullivan's **Smoke'M** is the final coloring to use on gray, smoky colored livestock, especially Charolais-cross cattle. Smoke'M provides excellent coverage to the hair to enhance the natural hair color while creating a thick, fuller appearance.

Directions: Shake well before each use. After grooming the leg with adhesive to the desired appearance, apply **Smoke'M Touch-Up**. Since colors of smoky colored cattle can vary significantly, combine the spray of Smoke'M Touch-Up with Brown, Jet Black, Black Finisher or White Touch-Up to help achieve the correct color shade. Color enhancements may be prohibited at some shows. To prevent clogging, spray can upside down to clear tip. Remove with Sullivan's Hocus Pocus and wash out with Sullivan's Clear Choice Livestock Shampoo.
