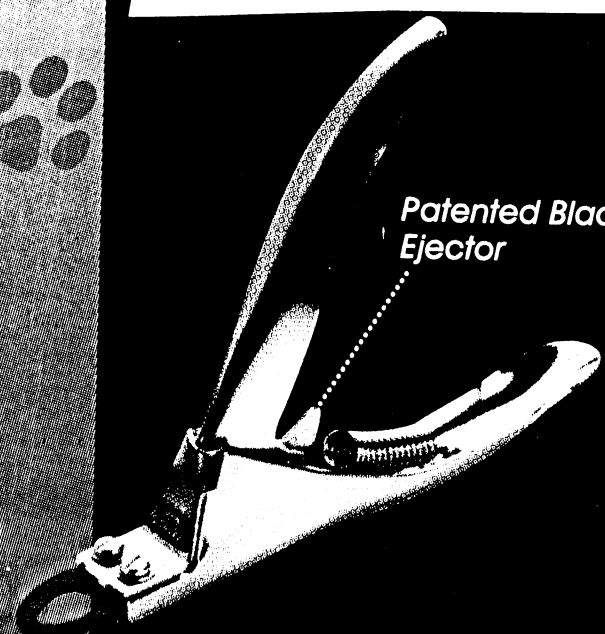

Patented Blade Ejector

Easy blade replacement with Resco No. 400 Blade Replacement Kit



Anyone can use a "Resco" nail Trimmer.

Hold the trimmer as pictured, with the name plate and screws facing away from you. Cut the nail even with the bottom of the animal's pad. If your pet's nails are

extremely long, shave just a little off the tips and wait a week and trim the nails again. This causes the blood vessels to retreat back into the nail and weekly trimming will allow you to trim your pet's nails to the desired length.

BLADE REPLACEMENT

Should your pet's nails split when cutting, then your trimmer is getting dull and the cutting blade should be replaced. To remove blade, push down on ejector tab with pin in place as shown. Squeeze handles to push blade forward for easy removal. To re-insert blade, push down on ejector tab and slide cutting blade in carefully. If the handles won't close easily, do not force them closed. Simply tap front of trimmer in palm of hand and blade should move and allow ejector tab to fall in place.
