

Daisy Lifter

Designed for medium term support at a maximum of one hour at a time. It has the ability to humanely lift sick or injured animals suffering from post-calving paralysis and trauma. Ideal for retrieving a down cow that has ended up in a water ditch or an ideal device for carting the cow back to the shelter of a warm barn.

- **Cow Support** - Reduces pressure points and keeps cow secure and humanely lifted
- **Carrying Bag** - Ensures all parts required will be there when you get to the paddock
- **Size Flexibility** - Standard and XL sizes allow for use with medium to large sized dairy breeds.
- **Comfort** - Adjustable rear straps ensures cows are lifted evenly and comfortably



Daisy Lifter Procedures:

1. Simply lay the sling out to the side of the cow ensuring it is laid out the correct way, roll the cow over on top of the sling (hip clamp is ideal tool for positioning the cow over top of the sling), maneuver the loader with the “C” hooks and attach.
2. Adjust the rear straps between the udder and the legs ensuring the seat pad is in the correct position just above the udder.
3. Draw the front straps between the front legs, the front straps are crossed over above the neck and attached to the opposite side of the gambel, this helps support the cow.
4. Before lifting, adjust tension of the rear adjustable straps to ensure an even and comfortable lift for the cow.
