

Hoof-Alive Coronet Soaker



Use For:

- Severe Cracks
- Extreme Dryness
- Promoting Growth

Use in conjunction with good shoeing or trimming.

Contents: 2 Soakers

Why soak the coronet? The coronet or coronary band has 3 “coriums” which grow the hoof wall. Any problem at the coronet will usually show up at the hoof wall. The soaking process goes to and treats the *source* of the problem rather than just the effect. After soaking the coronet area for about 2 weeks improvement should be seen.

Note: This soaking process will NOT help with navicular problems.

Directions for use - Read before using

Clean and dry the coronet.

Apply **Hoof-Alive** to the soaker fleece and adjust to the size of the coronet allowing soaker to fit loosely around the center of the coronet. Vet-wrap is recommended if shavings and other debris are present.

Every 48 hours lift the soaker up to pastern area and reapply (appx. 1-Tbl.) of Hoof-Alive to inside of soaker and to the crack itself. Leave soaker on for 2 weeks around the clock. After about 7 days cracks should be swelled closed.

Continue soaking for another week for interior healing.

After 2 week soaking apply Hoof-Alive just to the crack twice a week.

Caution: Do not use with caustic or other irritating substances. Soakers are made for use with Hoof-Alive ONLY!
