

Installation Instructions

- l. Locate mounting position on gusset to create a straight pull on the existing coupler handle.
- 2. Mark and drill two 9/32' diameter or 5/16" diameter holes in the gusset.
- 3. Bolt on the EZE-Latch handle using the 1/4" carriage bolts, washers, and nuts which are provided.
- 4. When you set up your cable length as in (5) below, your trailer coupler handle should be down and latched as for travel. The EZE-Latch handle should be pointing upward as in the photo. Run the cable through the coupler handle and adjust to provide the correct length of travel.
- 5. Crimp cable ferrules using electrical crimp pliers. Trim excess cable.
- 6. To operate, simply pull the handle down to release the coupler pin. Then use a long-handled hammer to slide the gooseneck lock out of the way.

Safety Feature: Please note that the RED CAP on the handle acts as a SAFETY FLAG to tell you that your trailer is safely hooked up. When the handle is **UP**, your trailer is **good to go**. When the handle is **DOWN**, you are **unhooked**. (As viewed from your rearview mirror)
