Feeding Directions:

To provide added calories to the diet feed 2 scoops (4 oz.) daily to the average 1100 lb. horse. Up to 4 scoops (8 oz.) can be fed daily if horse's body condition or activity level warrants the need for additional calories. 2 ounce measuring scoop inside.
