Natural Vitamin E

A supplemental source of natural vitamin E for all horses

Feeding Directions:

Feed daily at a rate of 100 IU per 100 lb. (200 IU to 1,000 IU per 100 kg) of body weight. The feeding level depends on the type of horse, level of activity, and nutritional and management practices that affect vitamin E needs. One scoop delivers 1,000 IU of vitamin E.

One scoop=12.5 grams.

Feeding Recommendations:

Top-dress onto daily grain ration.

Type of Horse	IU/day	Scoops/day
Maintenance.....	1,000.....	1
Stalled Horses or horses maintained on poor pasture.....	1,000-2,000.....	1-2
Intense training.....	3,000-5,000.....	3-5
Pregnant and lactating mares.....	3,000.....	3
Foals.....	3,000.....	3
Stallions.....	2,000.....	3

For daily levels above 5,000IU, consult with your veterinarian.

Ingredients:

D-alpha- tocopherol acetate (natural vitamin E), dehydrated alfalfa meal, flaxseed meal, stabilized rice bran, lignin sulfonate, natural and artificial flavors, preserved with propionic acid.

Indications:

Elevate Maintenance Pellets are ideal for horses maintained on diets composed largely of processed grains and stored forages. Such feedstuffs usually have low vitamin E content; thus, horses require vitamin E supplementation.

Vitamin E status can be determined by measuring serum tocopherol levels. Serum tocopherol levels below 2µg per ml are considered deficient in most horses.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place. Reseal lid during storage.
