Kid Milk Replacer

- A multi-species milk replacer recommended for feeding to calves, foals, piglets, lambs goat kids, deer fawn, veal calves, llamas and alpaca crias.
- Formulated with 24% all milk proteins and 24% fat for maximum nutrient absorption.
- Developed for infant animals from 2 days of age to weaning.

Mixing and Feeding Direction

All Start™ Milk replacer is recommended for calves, goat kids, lambs, pigs and other baby farm animals. Due to specific digestive needs, this milk replacer is not recommended for puppies and kittens.

Newborns should be given colostrum (dam's first milk) as early as possible and continued for the first 24 to 48 hours of life.

Refer to the following guidelines for mixing and feeding instructions. Remember, each animal is different and the guidelines below may need to be adjusted for body size and condition. In general, large animals will need more than smaller animals. Consult with a qualified veterinarian regarding health concerns.

For best mixing results, sprinkle the powder into warm (110°F) clean water and mix thoroughly with a whisk or powder mixer.

Calves- Mix 12 ounces of milk replacer (3 Measures*) into 3 quarts of warm (110°F) water. Feed 2-3 quarts twice daily until weaning.

Foals- Mix 8 ounces of milk replacer powder (2 Measures*) into 2 quarts of warm (110°F) water. Feed 1 to 2 quarts 4 times daily for the first 3 weeks, then 2 to 3 daily until weaning.

Lambs- Mix 4 ounces of milk replacer powder (1 Measure*) into 1 quart of warm (110°F) water. Feed 2 to 4 ounces of this solution 4 times daily for the first week, then 8 to 12 ounces 3 times daily until weaning.

Goat Kids and other small ruminants (Llama and Alpaca Cria, Deer Fawns, Elk Calves)- Mix 4 ounces of milk replacer powder (1 Measure*) into 1 ½ pints of warm

(110°F) water. Feed 2 to 4 ounces of this solution 4 times daily for the first week, then 8 to 12 ounces 3 times daily until weaning.

Piglets- Mix 4 ounces of milk replacer powder (1 Measure*) into 1 pint of warm (110°F) water. Feed 2 to 4 ounces of this solution 4 times daily for the first week. Increase the amount to 4 to 6 ounces of this solution daily for the second week, then 8 to 12 ounces twice daily until weaning.

*The measuring cup provided in the bag holds approximately 4 ounces of milk replacer powder. For greater accuracy, a suitable scale is recommended.
