Feeding Guide:

Ask your veterinarian for specific feeding instructions for your pet. Daily Feeding Recommendations are only a guide and a place to start. Grams are the most accurate form of measurement; cups are estimated from grams.

For best results:

We advise a gradual transition over 5-7 days for any new food. However, for dogs currently eating Prescription Diet g/d or low-fat foods (e.g. Prescription Diet i/d Low Fat, i/d Stress, z/d Low Fat Soy, c/d Low Fat), we recommend gradually transitioning to this food over a period of 10-14 days. Be patient and consistent.

- Exclusively feed the recommended Prescription Diet dry and wet foods.
- Keep fresh water available at all times.
- Have your veterinarian monitor your pet's condition.
- To prevent suffocation, keep the packaging out of the reach of pets & children.
