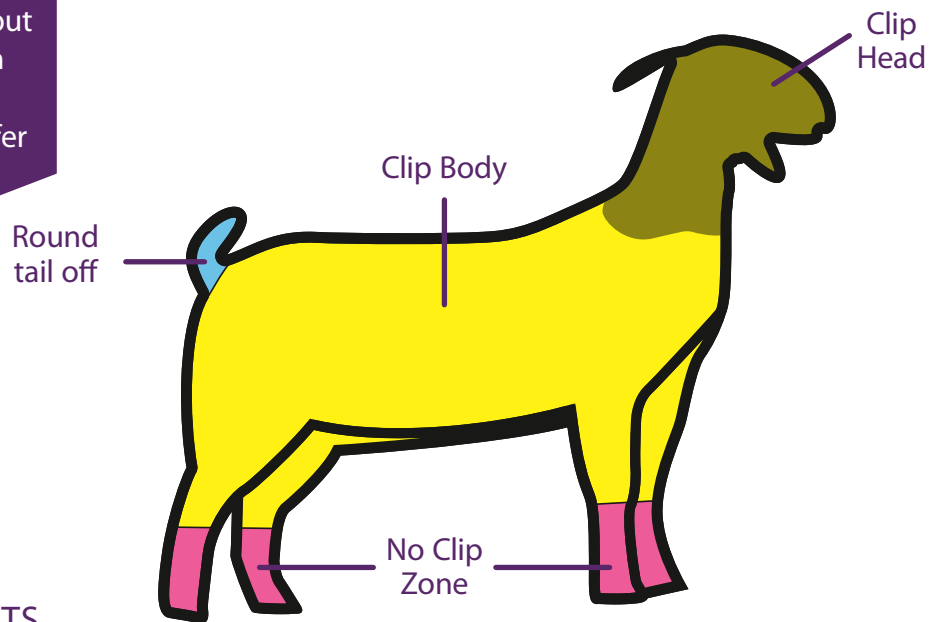


How to Clip Your Goat Like a Pro

Clipping is a great way to achieve a polished look for show day, but some methods are better than others. Show off your goat's best features by using ProStaffer Mike Harbour's very own clipping techniques.

Remember: Start at the head and work your way towards the tail.



WETHER GOATS

It's important for the judge to see the muscling in your market goat, so slick shearing the body is a must. Clip no more than 3 days before the show to ensure that hair is short and even.

Mike recommends the Lister Legend or Lister Star as a larger clipper or the Andis® Pulse ZR™ for a smaller clipper.

BREEDING DOES & BUCKS

Because there isn't a need for these goats to be slick sheered, it's easier to enhance your goat's shape with strategic clipping. Start clipping about a week out from your show so that you have time to precisely blend all sections.

Avoid clipping the top of the nose to the base of the horns; a rounded head shape is desirable.
