

# Egg Drench Made Simple

## ***Fitters Secret LLC***

Fitters Secret Egg Drench is a drench for growing beef, lambs, goats and pigs, based on the popular “home-made egg drench”. Fitters Secret Egg Drench is just as effective as the homemade version, but without the mess and storage issues. Mix the amount needed with water and drench or top dress. No more worrying about spoilage. The egg drench is a fantastic preshow drench to produce a firm but fresh top in your animal. The egg drench can also be used as a nutrient replacement when reducing feed to hold or reduce weight. Breeders can use the egg drench to maintain the pop and bloom on young animals prior to sale.

**Caution:** Refrigerate unused hydrated drench and wash all utensils after use.

For best results begin drenching or top dress application 10 to 14 days prior to show.

**For drenching:** Mix 6 volume ounces to one quart of water.

Cattle: 20 ounces of hydrated mixture 2 to 3 times a day.

On first day give 1/4 of recommended dosage, second day give 1/2 dosage, third day further full dosage.

Sheep/Goats/Swine:

1<sup>st</sup> day drench 3 oz twice daily

2<sup>nd</sup> day drench 5 oz twice daily

3<sup>rd</sup> day drench 10 oz twice daily

Repeat 3<sup>rd</sup> day directions for everyday after until desired results are achieved.

### **Top dress instructions:**

Cattle: Mix 5 ounces twice a day in feed.

Lambs/Goats/Swine over 50 pounds, feed 2 oz. in a.m., 1 oz. noon and 2 oz. p.m.

Lambs/Goats/Swine under 50 pounds, feed 1.3 oz. twice a day.

Be sure to supply ample fresh clean water

Drenching of lambs, goats and swine less than 50 pounds, reduce total amount given (give 7 ounces of mixed drench instead of 10 ounces).

Last 5 to 7 days prior to show reduce feed as necessary; however, continue supplementing with Egg Drench Made Simple. (Cattle feed normal)

Initially start off with reduced rates the first few days and increase as animals become accustomed to drench. Rates can be increased or decreased depending on the animal's needs but increases should be taken slow to prevent stomach upset. During testing no animal displayed any type of stomach upset, although overuse or abuse could result in unsatisfactory results or complications.
