OUT OF SIGHT DOESN'T MEAN OUT OF MIND

Any horse can develop equine gastric ulcer syndrome (EGUS). Research tells us gastric ulcers can be found in up to:

- 90% performance horses
- 60% all horses¹

Even beyond affecting your horse's quality of life, EGUS can affect your ability to enjoy your relationship with them.

TWO LEADING RISK FACTORS:

- Episodic feeding
- Stress

Some horses are more prone to stress than others, but for many, even small changes of routine can potentially lead to gastric ulcers.

Unfortunately, gastric ulcers aren't top-of-mind for many horse owners until their horse is already showing signs. The clinical signs of EGUS include:

- Poor performance
- Changes in behavior such as nervousness, aggression or self-mutilation
- Recurrent, low-grade colic (especially after eating)
- Inappetence, weight loss and/or poor body condition

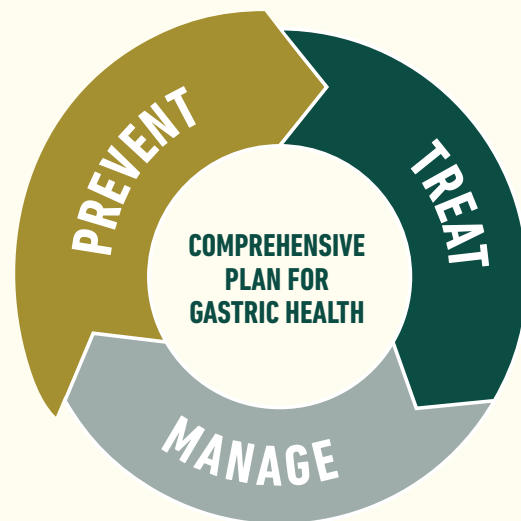

PREVENT

Give your horse the best chance at preventing gastric ulcers by staying in front of stress with ULCERGARD.



MANAGE

Manage your horse's gastric health daily. In addition to minimizing stress, here are some helpful tips that can help reduce your horse's risk for developing EGUS:

- Provide hay free-choice, utilizing a slow-feed hay net or feeder where possible.
- Consider adding alfalfa to their diet to help buffer acid.
- If concentrate is necessary, provide daily amount in frequent smaller meals, as opposed to twice per day in larger meals.
- Feed hay before concentrate.

TREAT

Sometimes, the impact of stress cannot be overcome. If you suspect your horse is suffering from gastric ulcers, talk to your veterinarian about scheduling a gastroscopy exam.

If ulcers are diagnosed, work with your veterinarian to develop the treatment plan that will work best for your horse.
