

Black Velvet Hair Dye Kit

Designed for livestock, Black Velvet turns gray, red-tinted or faded hair into a beautiful jet-black color with tremendous shine, softness, and body.

Preparing Animal for Dying: Do not shampoo or scrub the skin for 5 days prior to dying. Shampooing strips the natural oils from the skin and may cause the skin to be sensitive to the dye. Due to varying lengths of hair and differences in skin sensitivity, it is necessary to do a dye patch test on areas with shorter hair. For tips on using Black Velvet, go to www.sullivan supply.com/dy tips.

Directions: Wear protective gloves to protect hands from being stained. Combine the entire contents of the Dye (black bottle) and the Activator (red bottle) into a spray bottle, shake well and apply onto hair coat. Only mix enough product that can be applied within 5 minutes. Gently work into hair coat with glove-covered hands.

Be Aware: The amount of time to leave in the hair depends on the outside air temperature and length of hair. Do NOT exceed the following recommendations.

- If over 70° F, leave in the hair for up to 20 minutes maximum. Warmer temperatures accelerate the dying process, enabling the dye to work much faster.
- If under 70° F, leave in the hair up to 30 minutes maximum.

Rinse out with water immediately. If the dye is left in the hair longer than the suggested time period, skin irritation/burns may occur. Do not rub dye into the skin.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. This product is formulated for livestock only. Not for human use. This product may cause irritation to certain sensitive skinned individuals. If a rash should occur, discontinue use. Avoid eye contact. Keep from heat or flame. Use only in well ventilated areas. Do not take internally.
