- 1. ASSEMBLE Follow enclosed diagram drawings and instructions. Flip the unit over and saturate the Kover with Insecticide.
- 2. We recommend Gordons Backrubber & Pour On. This is a RTU (Ready to Use) .250% Permethrin. Safe on beef and dairy cattle. Available at most farm supply stores.
- 3. The Kover and attached reservoir must rotate freely. It will fit sloppy on the feeder. This enhances the life of the Kover and feeder.
- 4. Add Mineral. Do not fill over half full. If using Block mineral, break into softball size pieces. When adding mineral, use the pull strip to raise the Kover for accessibility to feeder. The unit must be the only source of mineral. It may take a week for the livestock to discover the mineral if they are not familiar with it.
- 5. Wait a week to fill the reservoir. Insecticide wicks out overnight. Fill weekly or as needed. If you get excessive drippage off the outer rim onto the ground, do not fill as often or only fill half full. The reservoir will empty completely. This does not mean it needs refilled as the Kover will be saturated with insecticide. It is up to you to judge how often to fill by use.
- 6. Feeder should not be staked down. If needed, drive a stake into the ground and place feeder over the stake.
- 7. If you purchased a Fly Killer Kover Kit (Kover with Reservoir & attachment hardware) and can't adapt to your feeder, you will have to drill a half inch hole down through the center of mineral tub. If you need help call 785-363-2655 for assistance.
- 8. If you prepare your insecticide, use a food grade mineral oil as a dilutant. DO NOT USE WATER, DIESEL FUEL OR VEGETABLE OIL.
- 9. End of fly season, remove felt Kover and replace with rubber cover. Store Kover flat with felt side down.
- 10. If Kover ever stops wicking, remove and power wash.

To Assemble – Remove all parts from the double threaded 9" stem. Place the short end of the stem through the center hole of the feeder. Lock vice grip on the top of the stem and place a SS Washer and Locknut on the underside stem.

Place Kover on top of the welded on washer, then the reservoir. Place a SS Washer on the stem in the reservoir, then the PVC space, yellow decal washer, and then the SS Nut. (This is nut is what determines the flow of the insecticide onto the felt Kover) To tighten use vice grips on the stem and tighten the nut inside with ¾" wrench <u>but</u> <u>do not use excessive force.</u> You are ready to place the SS reservoir lid and SS Locknut on the Reservoir.

Kover and assembled reservoir will fit loosely on the feeder.

Once assembled – place the unit on the ground with felt side upward and saturate felt with insecticide. Flip unit upright and add 50# of mineral. Wait a week after livestock start consuming the mineral to fill reservoir with insecticide and fill weekly thereafter.

Lice problem use the Fly Killer Kover for control.
