HOW TO USE

Remove And Open Package

Remove applicator from packaging. Using one applicator tube, hold it with the narrow end pointing up. Snap the outline of the tip back to allow access to the applicator. Holding applicator away from your and your cat's eyes, cut the applicator tip at notched line to open. Invert applicator over cat and use open end to part cat's hair. Apply this product at a spot between the cat's shoulder blades. Squeeze the entire contents of the applicator and direct the solution in one spot and onto the cat's skin. Allow the area to dry. Use only one applicator per treatment. Do not apply more frequently than once every 30 days.

FREQUENCY OF APPLICATION

This product should be applied once every 30 days. Treatment remains effective, even after bathing, water immersion, or exposure to sunlight. Do not reapply for 30 days.
