Ingredients

Feeding Instructions

The following feeding program is recommended as a guideline only, with discretionary clinical adjustments for proper weight maintenance. With your veterinarian's approval, offer increasing amounts of the new food with decreasing amounts of the old food.

5 lbs	1/2
10 lbs	7/8
20 lbs	1-3/8
30 lbs	1-7/8
40 lbs	2-1/4
50 lbs	2-5/8
60 lbs	3
80 lbs	3-5/8
100 lbs**	4-1/8

*This daily amount should be divided into several small meals throughout the day.

**For each additional 10 lbs of body weight, feed an additional 114 kilocalories.
